2. Talent Identification	a. To sit on the Children's Team selection panel. b. To manage all aspects of trial events – technical skills tests, fitness tests, time trials. c. Assist the NPPM in the running of any talent identification events. d. To assist the NPPM in the development and maintenance of a database of talented athletes.	
3. Develop holistic athletic lifestyles	a. Work with ski training institutions and regional centres to develop off snow training programmes that prepare young talent to become an athlete. b. Contribute to the development and implementation of athlete and parent education programmes covering such areas as Strength & Conditioning, Nutrition, Sport Psychology and Coaching Principles.	
4. Leading British Children's Team Coaching	a. Work closely with the British Children's team management group in planning and executing logistics associated with running the British Children's team. b. Lead the Coaching staff during all training and competition elements of the annual programme of the British Children's Team. c. Co-ordinate coaching staff at International Children's races.	
5. Influence & lead other coaches.	a. Be involved in the development of a Snowsport GB coaching pathway and structure with particular emphasis on children's coaching.
